

**TERMS FOR SUCCESSFUL ACCOMPLISHMENT OF PRACTICALS IN
MICROBIOLOGY II FOR 3rd CLASS STUDENTS OF GENERAL MEDICINE -
WINTER SEMESTER OF THE ACADEMIC YEAR 2023/2024**

1. All students have to attend their practical classes with the study group they belong to. A student can attend practical classes with a different study group only if he studies according to an individual study programme.
2. A student can register for the microbiology exam based on active participation in all practical exercises and passing the test with a success rate of at least 75% and passing the practical exam rated at least grade E during practical exercises. During each practical exercise, the student prepares a protocol and hands it over to the teacher on the next practical exercise.
3. Pre-terms will be assigned to students who have 100% participation in the practical exercise, a test with at least 95% and a practical exam graded A.
4. A student who cannot attend practical exercise for serious medical reasons must apologize and submit a confirmation of the reason for non-participation. The maximum tolerance is one absence..
5. Compensation for missed practical classes will be organised according to the valid Study Regulations and the Dean`s Regulations at the end of the practical course; the date and the time will be arranged with the teacher responsible for the practical classes.
6. A student, who will miss practical class(es) without serious reason, will not submit all protocols or will fail any of the test, cannot register for exam on Microbiology.
7. Students, who will not fulfill the terms for registering to the exam on Microbiology in regular time, have to follow the rules published in the valid Study Regulations.
8. Students can contact teachers of the Institute of Microbiology by e-mail and after an agreement with a teacher also personally or by call in the Teams.
