

CONDITIONS AND METHOD OF PERFORMING

THE MEDICAL CHEMISTRY EXAM

academic year 2023/2024

(study branches - **General Medicine** and **Dentistry**)

The examination from the subject Medical Chemistry will be held **in person**, in **written form** and will consist of **3 parts: A, B, C**.

Part A contains 35 questions with offered options (realized in Moodle system)

Part B consists of 5 calculation questions

Part C presents 2 open questions

- **Part A** of the exam is realized **online in the Moodle system in the computer room of MFCU**. The room and the beginning of the exam will be announced directly in AIS2 and it is necessary to be present at least 15 minutes before the start of the exam.
- Before the start of the exam, the student will identify himself/herself with an ID card or ISIC to supervising teachers.
- The result of Part A (passed/failed) will be displayed to the student directly in the Moodle system after its completion.
- **Only the student who succeeds in Part A continues in Parts B and C**. This part of the exam is carried out on the same day - the room and time of the test will be announced to the student in advance.

To successfully pass the exam, it is necessary to obtain a minimum of 70% of the possible points in total from the whole test, where:

1. In **Part A** it is necessary to achieve **at least 70 %** of the possible points
2. In **Part B**, it is necessary to achieve **at least 60 %** of possible points and **at the same time to answer completely correctly at least 2 calculations**.
3. **Part C** contains **2 open questions**, which will be elaborated by the student and the **examiner will evaluate the level of knowledge**. The student has to answer each of the open questions.

The student will find the result of the exam in the AIS system not later than the day following the day of the exam.

Examiners will announce the office hours during which the student can come and review his test.

Practical comments:

- **Part C questions as well as the types of calculations will be published on the website of the Institute together with the Syllabus of the subject Medical Chemistry.**
- Students **register the date of the exam** explicitly via **the AIS2 system**. The AIS2 system closes the **registration/canceling** of exam always **24 hours before the exam date**.
- **A first-year student** has three exam terms in a given academic year: a regular date and 2 repetitive terms. **A student with a transferred course** has only two terms: a regular term and a repetitive one.
- It is necessary to bring a scientific calculator for the calculation part of the exam (calculators with external input are not allowed).
- The protection of the upper respiratory tract by face mask or respirator will be regulated by actual epidemiology situation.
